Rubbish bag trial is a big success

Environmental levy on plastic shopping bags

Since 2009, the environmental levy has been set at 50 cents for each plastic shopping bag provided at registered retail outlets. Shoppers are also encouraged to bring their own bags as part of the scheme.

HOUSEHOLD waste levy scheme has been tried out in Tai Kok Tsui (大角咀) and according to environmentalists, the amount of rubbish fell. Friends of the Earth (地 球之友) and Greeners Action (綠領行動) trialled the scheme in a residential block between 21 November and 20 December. The government is also holding a **consultation** on the waste charges at the moment.

Each household was given 15 15-litre plastic bags worth HK\$3 a piece, and 45 five-litre bags, worth HK\$1 each. The participants were paid the value for the unused bags at the end of the trial.

Households produced 30 percent less rubbish on average. Before the trial, households threw away 110 kilograms. This fell to 76.9kg. Daily recycling increased from 5.4kg to 22.2kg. About 78 percent of participants said their awareness of reducing waste improved. Thirty-eight percent said they would be motivated to reduce waste if they were charged HK\$1 for each five litres they produced.

Friends of the Earth said the plan highlighted the value of charging individual flats for waste instead of an entire residential block.



Parents go on march over cross-border school places

ARENTS marched in protest over the Education Bureau's (教育 局) decision to set aside almost 1.200 Primary 1 places in Tuen Mun (屯門) for cross-border students. They said it deprives local children of choice.

The parents marched from Tuen Mun Government Offices to Tuen Mun Town Hall with banners and balloons. They called on the Bureau to withdraw the policy. They also demanded that it lists schools within 40 minutes travelling time from the border.

Cross-border students will be able to apply to one of 3,177 places in Hong Kong. There are 1,198 in Tuen Mun, 1,157 in Yuen Long (元朗) and 200 in Tung Chung (東涌). Some schools in Tuen Mun are opening extra classes to cope. Three schools are to open four to nine Primary 1 classes.
